**CURRICULUM NOTES**

1. 2019-2020 Academic Year Curriculum will be applied to all students.
2. Students, who have completed Summer Practice (Construction Site) will enroll INAR 3333 Summer Practice (Construction Site) course in the first semester following the summer practice. Before enrolling in INAR 3333 Summer Practice (Construction Site), students are required to successfully complete ISG 9110 *İş Sağlığı ve Güvenliği I* (for foreign students ISG 9120) and 20 workdays of Construction Site practice. Transfer students, who have completed their summer practice (construction site), but have not enrolled in the course, can take both ISG 9110 (for foreign students ISG 9120) and INAR3333 in the same semester.
3. Students, who have completed Summer Practice (Office) will enroll INAR 4433 Summer Practice (Office) course in the first semester following the summer practice. Before enrolling in INAR 4433 Summer Practice (Office), students are required to complete 20 workdays Office practice.
4. Students who have completed Erasmus+ Summer Practice will enroll INAR 3333 Summer Practice (Construction Site) or INAR 4433 Summer Practice (Office) in the first semester following the summer practice. Interior Architecture and Environmental Design Summer Practice Principles are also applied to these students.
5. Students who have successfully completed INAR 3333 Summer Practice (Construction Site) as of the beginning of 2018-2019 Academic Year are exempt from ISG 9110 *İş Sağlığı ve Güvenliği I* and ISG 9210 *İş Sağlığı ve Güvenliği II* (for foreign students ISG 9120 and 9220).
6. Students, who are enrolled in/or successfully completed INAR 4410 Interior Design V and/or INAR 4420 Interior Design Graduation Project in and before 2018-2019 Academic Year, are exempt from INAR 3334 Professional Practices for Interiors.



7. Students are not allowed to take any university elective courses offered in Turkish. Non-faculty elective courses offered in Turkish (within the limits of 6 ECTS) that have been taken before 2018-19 Academic Year Fall Semester, will be counted towards university elective credits.
8. The courses listed below (successfully fulfilled as of the beginning of 2018-19 Academic Year Fall Semester) will be counted for the fulfillment of university elective credits:
  - Non-faculty electives (including the ones in Turkish within the limits of 6 ECTS)
  - UFND courses other than those counted as the equivalent of UFND 2020, UFND 6120, ISG 9110 and/or ISG 9210.
9. Students cannot be exempt from attendance for the courses with applied course hours in which they reenroll because of their prior failure or withdrawal.
10. As of 2018-19, students with an entry year of 2008 and before will be considered eligible for graduation upon having successfully completed all courses in the curriculum and having 141 Yaşar Credits.
11. For the students who successfully completed both INAR 216 and INAR 3319, INAR 216 course; for the students who successfully completed both INAR 132 and INAR 2233, INAR 132 course; for the students who successfully completed both INAR 117 and INAR 1111, INAR 117 course; for the students who successfully completed both INAR 113 and INAR 1111, INAR 113 course can be counted as a faculty elective.

**Provisional Article 1 (Faculty Board Decision)**

Students, who successfully acquired 190 ECTS as of the beginning of 2018-2019 Academic Year Fall semester, are exempt from University Elective Courses. This item is only valid in 2018-2019 Academic Year.

**Provisional Article 2 (Faculty Board Decision)**

Students, who have completed their summer practice (construction site), but have not enrolled in INAR 3333 Summer Practice (Construction Site) course as of the beginning of 2018-2019 Academic Year, are exempt from ISG 9110 (for foreign students ISG 9120). This item is only valid in 2018-2019 Academic Year.
