Qualifications:

Bachelor and/or PhD degree in Interior Architecture (and Environmental Design) is required.

The candidates are expected to meet the appointment criteria determined by the Senate of Yaşar University. Applicants for Professorship position should have at least 5 refereed publications (at least 3 of them should be indexed by WoS citation index, and 2 of them by Scopus); applicants for Associate Professorship applicants should have 5 refereed publications (at least 2 of them should be indexed by WoS index, and 2 of them by Scopus); and applicants for Assistant Professorship position should have at least 3 refereed publications (at least one of them should be indexed by Scopus and one of them by ULAKBİM or Scopus).
